5. Attachment 1A, the NMCI phase-in schedule is provided as an attachment to the solicitation, and will become part of the integrated master schedule and incorporated into the resultant contract. For years 2001 and 2004 through 2008, offerors must use the minimum quantities specified in that attachment and provided in Part One of the solicitation. For years 2002 and 2003, offerors may propose to phase into the quantities specified for 2004 in its most efficient manner. That is, offerors must propose minimum quantities (for Items 0001-0005 and 0007-0009 only) for 2002 and 2003. Those quantities must not be less than those provided for 2001, and must not exceed those provided for 2004.

All other terms and conditions of Solicitation N00024-00-R-6000 remain unchanged, and in full force and effect.
