

terminates in the wiring closet in bldg 7113. The fourth fiber pair originates in the wiring closet in Bldg

7250 and terminates in the wiring closet in Bldg 7114 in accordance with the attached document entitled Statement of Objectives for fiber usage at Great Lakes Recruit Training Center.

b. A conformed copy of the revised contract is made a part of this modification as a result of the changes outlined herein.

**Statement of Objectives for Fiber Usage
at
Great Lakes Recruit Training Center**

1.0 INTRODUCTION

NETC has built and installed several classrooms in buildings 7111, 7112, 7113 and 7114 at the Recruit Training Center, Great Lakes Naval Training Center in North Chicago, IL. NETC is currently negotiating with NMCI/EDS to provide connectivity to the classroom environment. Until that service can be provided via the NMCI contract, NETC requests the temporary use of some available, 'Dark', unused, Single Mode fiber between buildings 7111 - 7250, 7112 - 7250, 7113-7250 and 7114-7250.

2.0 DESCRIPTION: Following are general descriptions of NETC's Fiber requirement.

- **Request usage of spare, unused, 'Dark' fiber between buildings 7111-7250, 7112-7250, 7113-7250 and 7114-7250** - NETC requests the usage of four pairs of single mode fiber from the NMCI cable plant at the Recruit Training Center, Great Lakes Recruit Training Center in North Chicago, IL. The first fiber pair originates in the wiring closet in bldg 7250 and terminates in the wiring closet in bldg 7111. The second fiber pair originates in the wiring closet in Bldg 7250 and terminates in the wiring closet in Bldg 7112. The third fiber pair originates in the wiring closet in Bldg 7250 and terminates in the wiring closet in Bldg 7113. The fourth fiber pair originates in the wiring closet in Bldg 7250 and terminates in the wiring closet in Bldg 7114.
