This modification is issued to add a clause authorizing use of undefinitized contractual actions (UCAs) in support of urgent requirements. Each undefinitized contractual action shall be issued via a task order. Accordingly, contract clause 6.0 entitled "Special Terms and Conditions" is hereby modified to incorporate the following clause:

6.35 UNDEFINITIZED CONTRACTUAL ACTIONS (UCAs)

Under urgent and unforeseen circumstances, the government may authorize the contractor to commence services prior to definitizing the requirements of the task order. In such instances, the government will provide the contractor a requirements document and request the contractor to submit a not-to-exceed price and a proposed definitization schedule. Upon agreement of the parties to a not-to-exceed price and definitization schedule, the government will issue a task order incorporating a not-to-exceed price, definitization schedule and limitation of government obligation. The limitation of government obligation shall be equal to 50 percent of the not-to-exceed price. The definitization schedule should endeavor to definitize the task order within 180 days after the effective date of the task order or before completion of 40 percent of the effort to be performed, whichever occurs first. When using UCAs, the parties agree to incorporate into bilateral task orders the following three required clauses:

- FAR 52.216-23 Execution and Commencement of Work (APR 1984)
- FAR 52.216-24 Limitation of Government Liability (APR 1984)
- FAR 52.216-25 Contract Definitization

The above clauses are removed upon definitization and full funding. All task orders issued under this authority shall be treated as firm-fixed-price from their inception.

A CONFORMED COPY OF THE REVISED CONTRACT IS MADE A PART OF THIS MODIFICATION AS A RESULT OF THE CHANGES OUTLINED HEREIN.

All other terms and conditions of Contract N00024-00-D-6000 remain unchanged, and in full force and effect.
